

Dr. Kenneth Schultz Fusion Energy Scholarship

The Fusion Energy Division of the American Nuclear Society will award the first annual Dr. Kenneth Schultz Fusion Energy Scholarship to an out standing ***undergraduate student***. Students who have a demonstrated an interest in fusion energy and fusion energy technology are invited to ***apply by October 15th 2016*** for this ***\$2500 scholarship***.

To apply, send the following to ***Dr. Leigh Winfrey***, winfrey@mse.ufl.edu, with the subject: LASTNAME Schultz Scholarship 2016, no later than 11:59pm PDT, October 15th 2016.

- 1) A completed application form
- 2) A copy of your unofficial transcript
- 3) A personal statement of 500 words or less that addresses your interest and involvement in fusion energy
- 4) A list of three references. Please ask these references to email a recommendation no longer than 1 page to ***Dr. Leigh Winfrey***, winfrey@mse.ufl.edu, with the subject: LASTNAME Schultz Scholarship. At least one letter should be from a person that can speak to your interest in and participation in fusion course work or research.
- 5) Official transcripts, these may usually be ordered online and can be sent directly from your registrar to Dr. Winfrey.

Please note the following requirements:

- 1) Students who will be undergraduates during the 2016-2017 school year may apply
- 2) Students who have demonstrated interest in fusion energy are eligible, this may be demonstrated by having conducted research in fusion or through fusion course work.
- 3) Students who are majoring in science, math, or engineering may apply
- 4) At least one reference should directly address the student's participation in fusion related research or course work
- 5) All references should be professional, no personal or character references will be accepted
